Countable and uncountable nouns

Countable nouns:

carrots olives
apples prawns
chillies peas
onions nuts



Uncountable nouns:

bread sugar
cheese oil
water meat
soup tomato sauce

THERE IS and THERE ARE

There IS (singular or uncountable)

There ISN'T (negative form)

There ARE (plural)

There AREN'T (negative form)

* Pot ser traduït com "hi ha". Recorda **THERE IS = THERE'S**



SOME and ANY

SOME: affirmative sentences
There's some cheese.

ANY: negative and interrogative
*There aren't any noodles.
Is there any sugar in the recipe?*

* **Són determinants indefinits.**



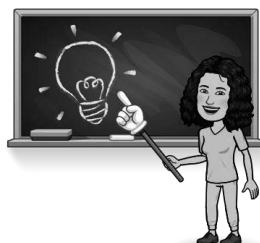
THERE IS/ARE questions

Are there any olives? **COUNTABLE PLURAL**

Is there an olive? **COUNTABLE SINGULAR**

Is there any tomato sauce in the recipe? **UNCOUNTABLE**

THERE IS/ARE answers

Is there any salt?
Yes, there is.
No, there isn't.

Are there any chillies?
Yes, there are.
No, there aren't.
